Amateur-Owner-Handler Class (effective as of 1/1/2009)

Chapter 3, Section 7 - The Amateur-Owner-Handler Class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineliaible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

Winners of the above Non-Regular Classes are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed Competition.

The Parade will not be judged. For each entry in the Parade of Rescues, indicate "Parade of Rescues" in the space provided for additional classes. NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class - For Brood Bitches & two of their Produce (for all except Dachshunds, at least two but not more than three). Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class & must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owners of the Brood Bitch need not be the owners of the Produce only to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce, placing will be made to the Brood Bitches. Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or a Non-Regular Class other than Brood Bitch.

Stud Dog & Brood Bitch will not be eligible for Best of Breed Competition, if based only on a first place winning in these classes. NR2.09300. 
