### **Amateur-Owner-Handler Class (effective as of 1/1/2009)**

Chapter 3, Section 7 - The Amateur-Owner-Handler Class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

The Parade will not be judged. For each entry in the Parade of Rescues, indicate "Parade of Rescues" in the space provided for additional classes. **NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class** - For Brood Bitches & two of their Produce (for all except Dachshunds, at least two but not more than three). Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class & must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owners of the Brood Bitch need not be the owners of the Produce. Produce only to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce, placing will be made to the Brood Bitches. Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or a Non-Regular Class other than Brood Bitch.

Stud Dog & Brood Bitch will not be eligible for Best of Breed Competition, if based only on a first place winning in these classes.

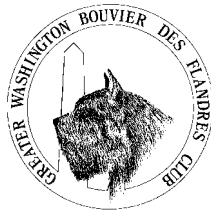

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
